Peer evaluation process

Academic Peer Assessment The review process for articles published in Mundo Fesc is “ double blind ” where the identities of the evaluators will not be known to the author and, in turn, the evaluation pairs will also not know the (s) identity (es) of (los) author (es), to maintain the impartiality of the evaluation. The manuscripts accepted to initiate evaluation of academic peers are sent by at least two external arbitrators (national and international) with academic and investigative suitability and

expertise in the area. In the event that any of the evaluations is negative or when after fifteen days no response is received from any of the evaluation pairs, a third arbitrator or evaluation couple will be sent.

Open access policy

This magazine provides immediate open access to its content, based on the principle that offering the public free access to research helps a greater global exchange of knowledge.

Mundo Fesc magazine does NOT file charges for applying or processing articles.

Authors who submit their articles to Mundo Fesc magazine, they empower it to be their first means of publication and to exercise on the works presented the powers of communication and dissemination established in the “ Letter of presentation of article ”, in which parameters are established according to the [Creative Commons License Attribution-NonCommercial 4.0 International](#).
